You can easily share your custom fundraising page by creating a QR code. Please use the instructions below:

- 1. On a desktop using Google Chrome, navigate to your fundraising page or our general donation page (if you do not have a fundraising page)

About Trevor

The Trevor Project is the leading suicide prevention and crisis intervention organization for lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, and questioning (LGBTQ+) young people.

The Trevor Project's mission is to end suicide among LGBTQ+ young people.

Top-Line Statistics:

- LGBTQ+ youth are more than four times as likely to attempt suicide than their peers (Johns et al., 2019; Johns et al., 2020).
- The Trevor Project estimates that more than 1.8 million LGBTQ+ youth (13-24) seriously consider suicide each year in the U.S.
 and at least one attempts suicide every 45 seconds.
- The Trevor Project's <u>2024 U.S. National Survey on the Mental Health of LGBTQ Young People</u> found that 39% of LGBTQ young people seriously considered attempting suicide in the past year—and young people who are transgender, nonbinary, and/or people of color reported higher rates than their peers.

Social Support and Acceptance Statistics:

- LGBTQ+ young people who reported feeling accepted by the adults in their lives typically had more than 40% lower odds of attempting suicide in the past year.
- LGBTQ+ youth who live in a community that is accepting of LGBTQ+ people reported much lower rates of attempting suicide than those who do not.
